### **Event Details :-**

Institute Staff Welfare Committee organized Group Accident Guard Policy Guidance Session for faculty members and administrative staff on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2022. This session was conducted by Mr. Chetan Ranalakar and he shared important features of the 'Group Accident Guard Policy' and digital account opening process of Indian Post.

According to guidelines by R. C. Patel Educational Trust about 'Group Accident Guard Policy', every employee should be participating in same insurance policy because of it has less premium and maximum benefits for insured person. This policy is announced by TATA AIG and it has Rs. 399 per year premium with following features.

- Accidental Death: Rs.10 Lakh
- Permanent disability: Rs.10 Lakh
- Hospital Expenses: Rs. 60 Thousand
- Rs.1000 per day for admit (10 days)
- OPD Expenses: Rs. 30000
- In case of accidental paralysis: Rs.10 Lakh
- Hospital Travel Expenses for family: 25,000
- All type of accidents is covered in this policy

After completion of the session, staff members proceed to open digital account and Group Accident Guard Policy.

Hon. Meenakshi Tai was stricken with polio at a very young age after her birth and was never able to walk on her own feet. Hon. Ms. Meenakshi Nikam herself is a disabled person who overcame poverty and stood up through sewing and created self-employment for many widowed and disabled women like herself. Today, many needy girls have got employment due to this organization known as "Swayam Deep." Her small work started with needle, thread and sewing machine, today she is doing this small work through the organization Swayam Deep. So far, she has been honored with "*Vasundhara Ratna Award*" awards from Maharashtra and she has gained fame and recognition as a 'social entrepreneur.' Hon. Ms. Meenakshi Nikam's great work for the disabled mass was noticed by the Governor of Maharashtra State and nominated as a member on the Senate Board of Kavayitri Bahinabai Choudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

Institute was invited to Hon. Meenakshi Tai for share her opinions and motivational life journey with faculty members and students. Respected Director Dr. Vaishali Patil madam felicitated to Hon. Ms. Meenakshi Nikam and addressed to faculty members and students about adoption of entrepreneurial skill along with value addition in social aspects.
