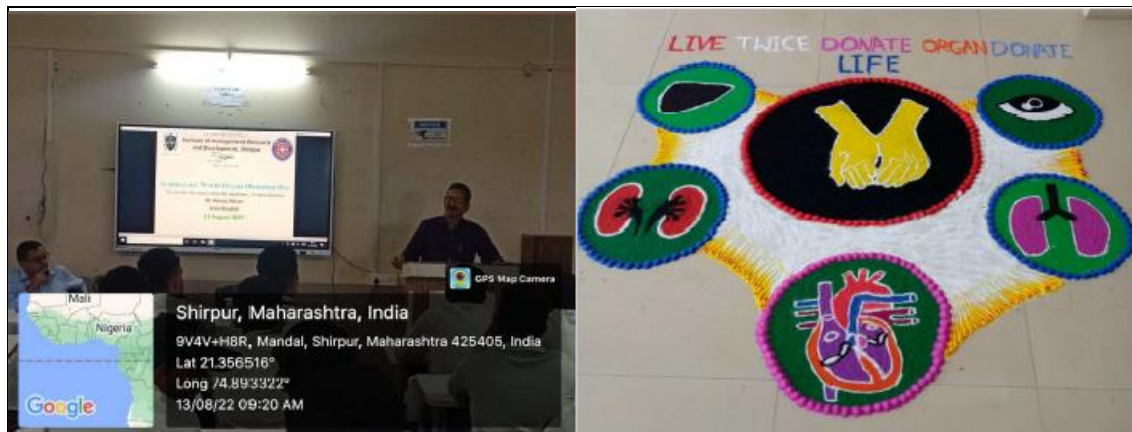

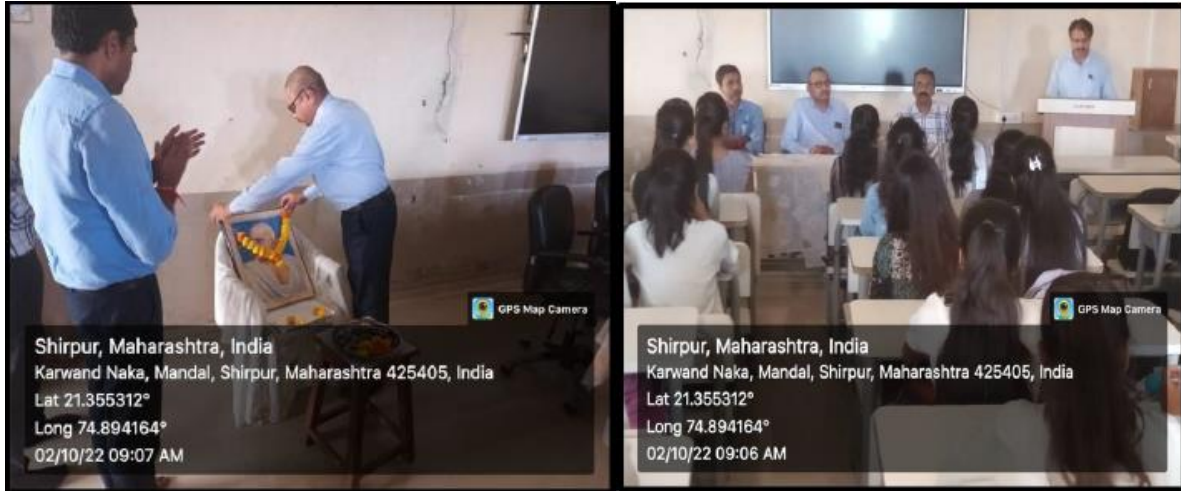
**Event Detail :-**

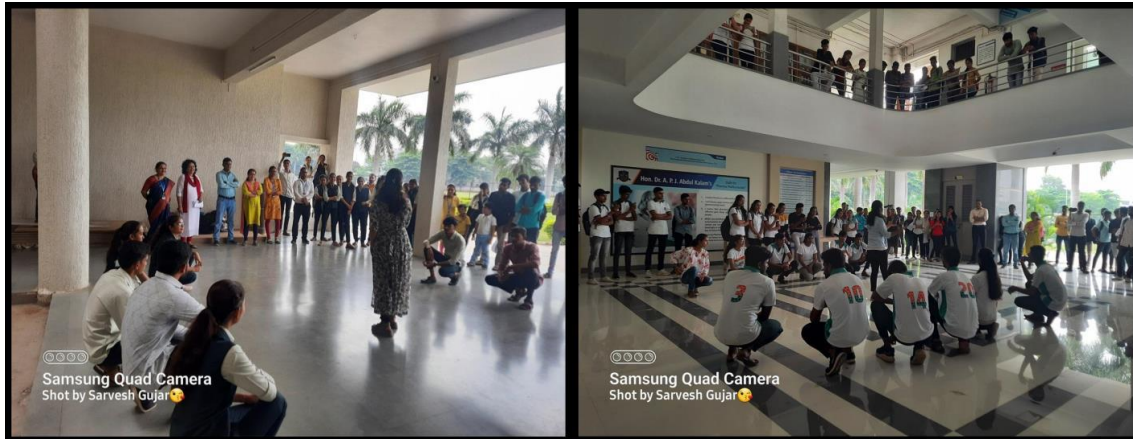
**Event Detail** :-

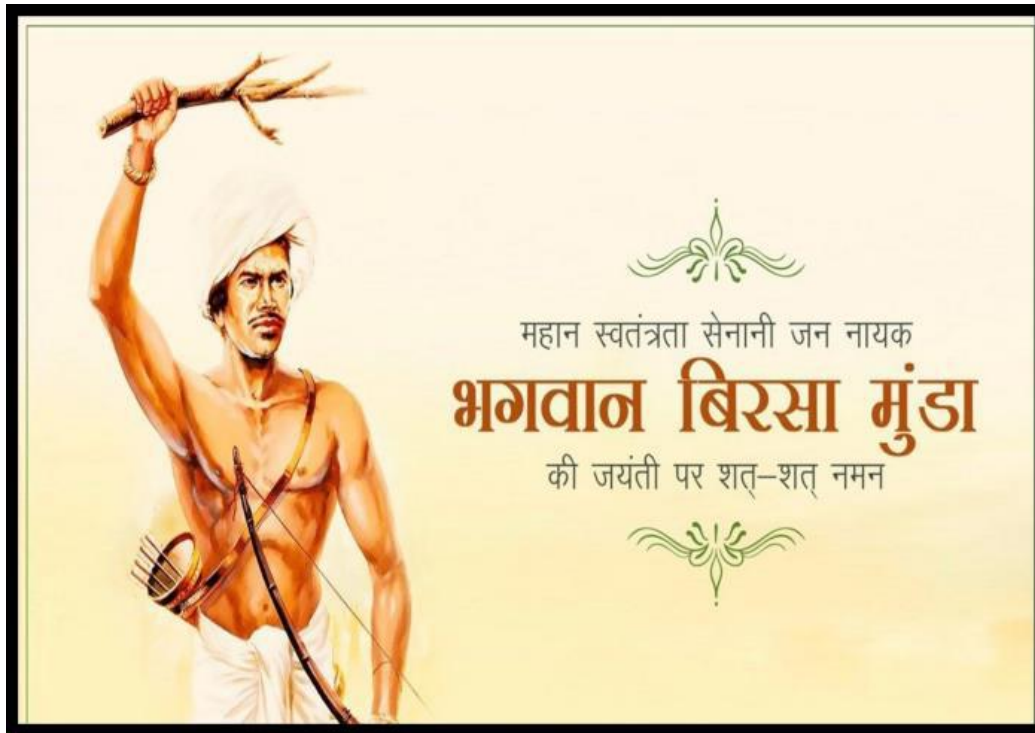

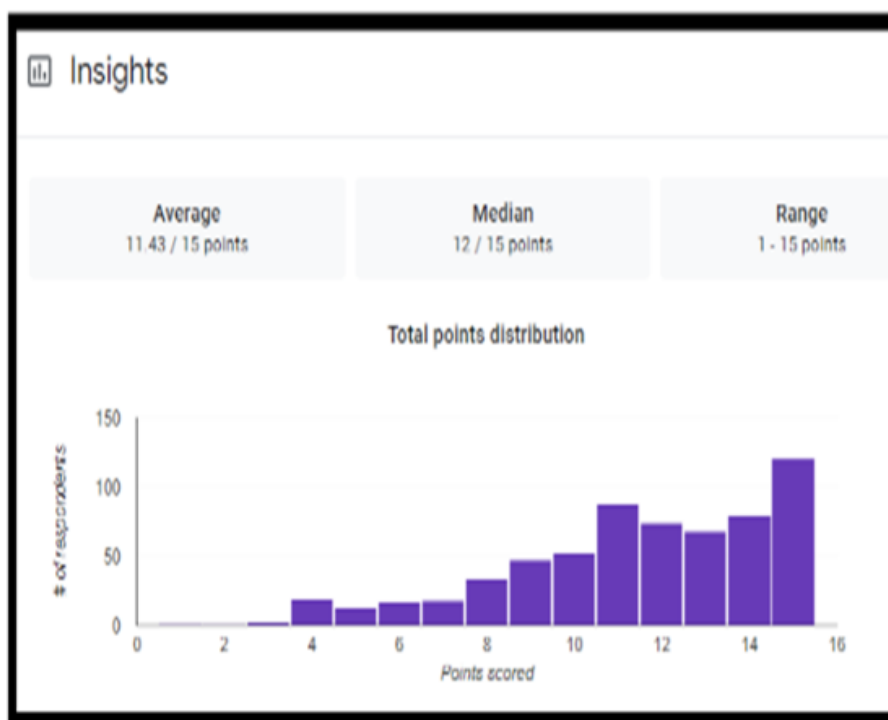
**Event Name :-**AIDS Awareness Online Quiz
