

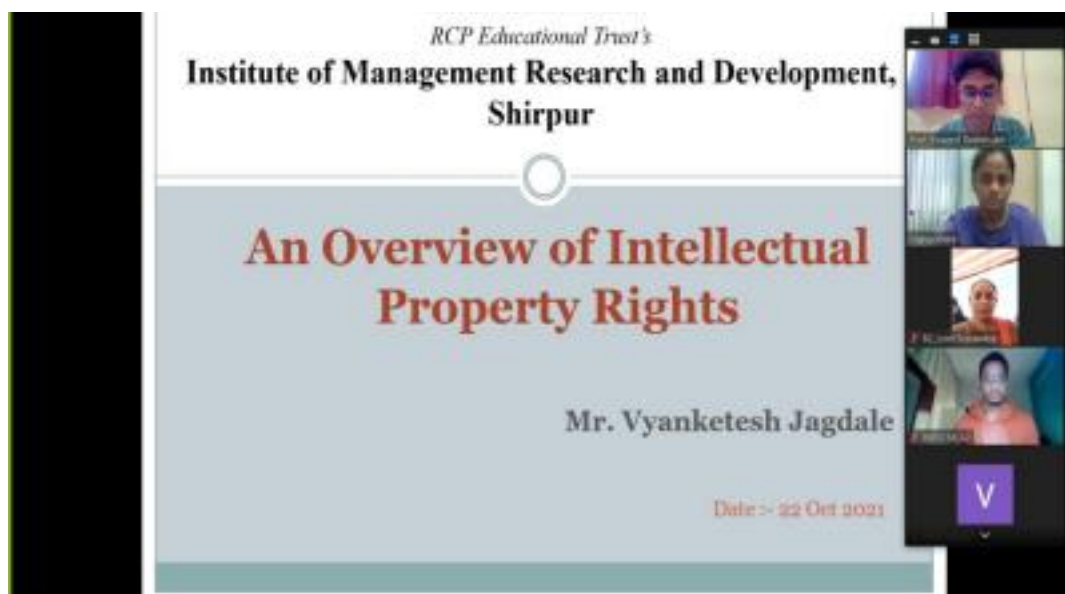
**Event Name:** - An Overview of Intellectual Property Rights

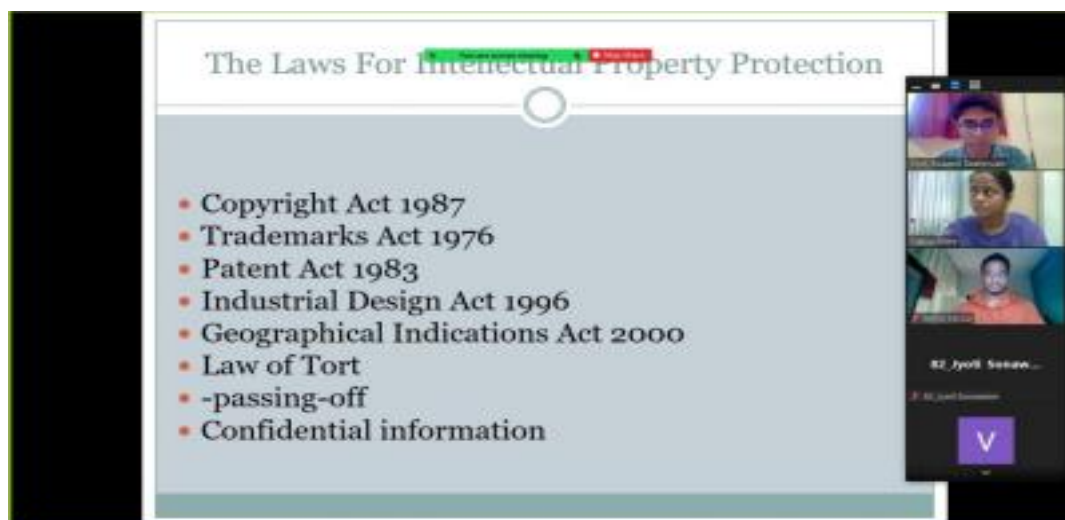

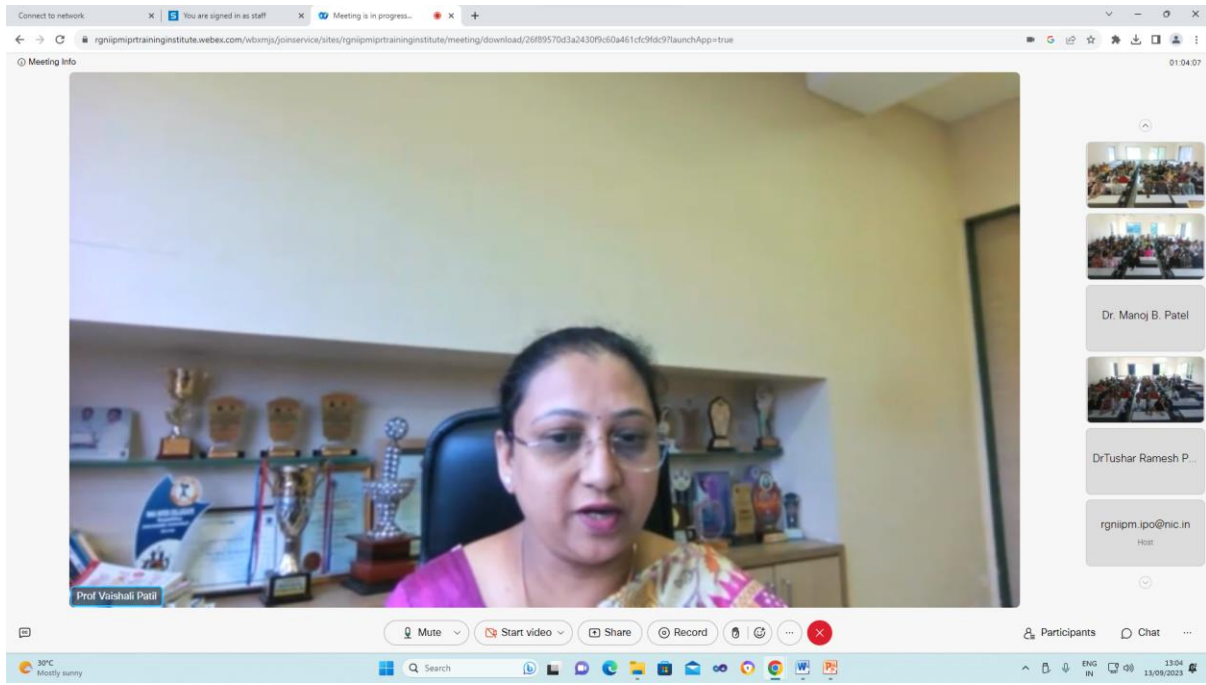
**Event Detail:-**

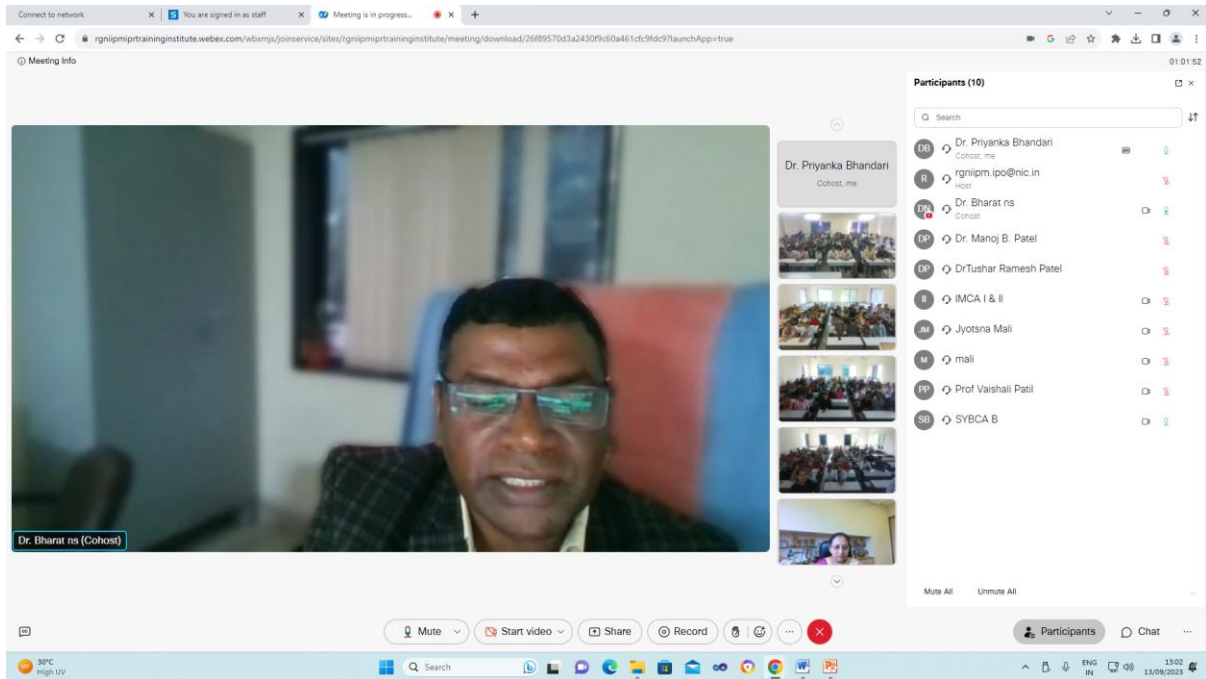
