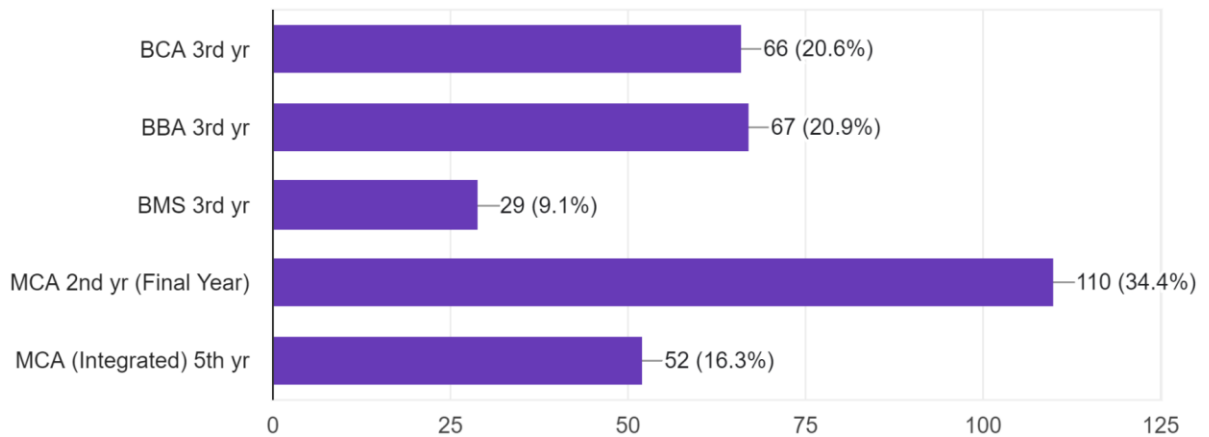

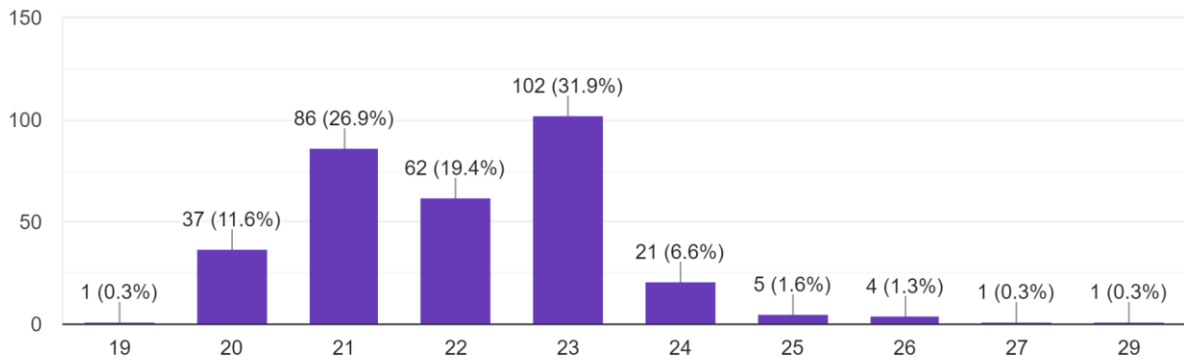

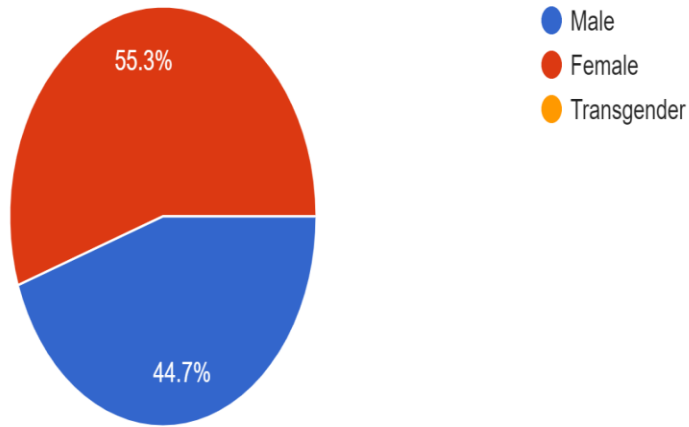

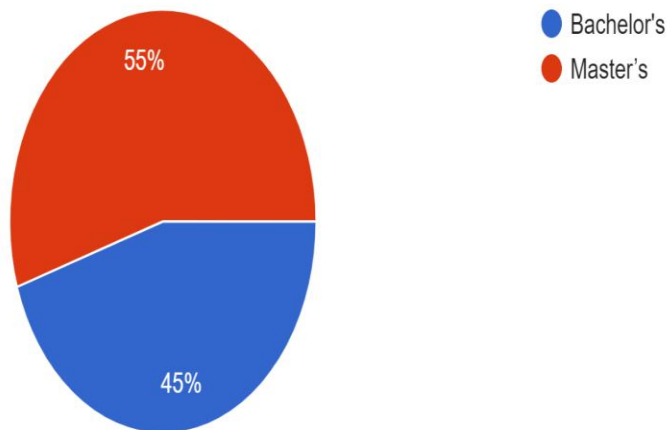

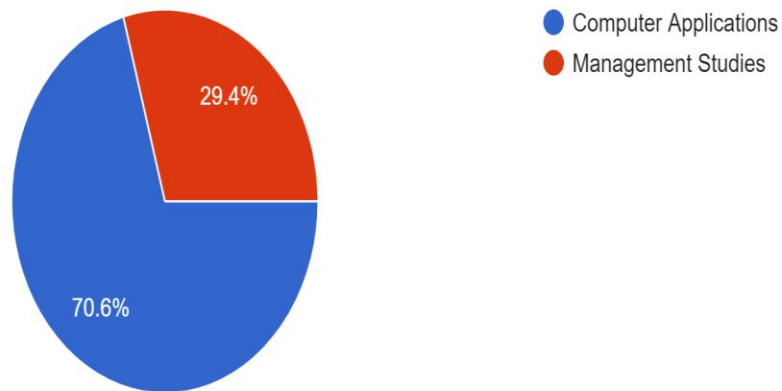
Which degree program are you pursuing now ?

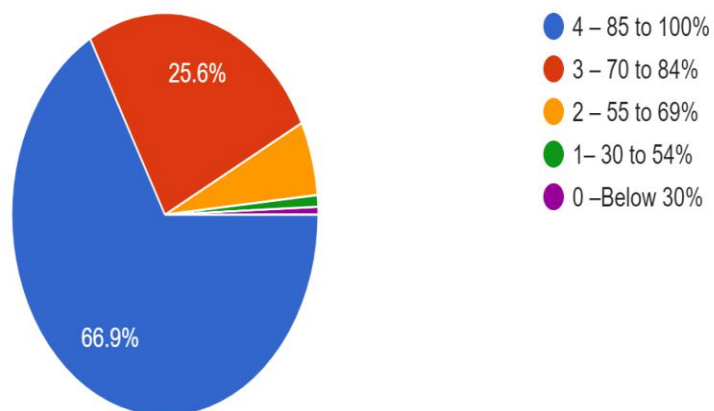
Which subject area are you currently pursuing?

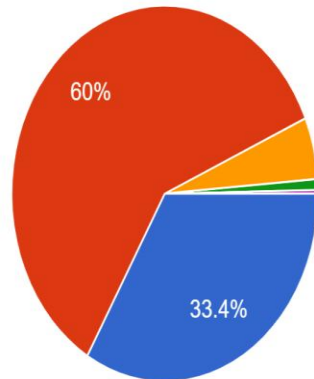
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

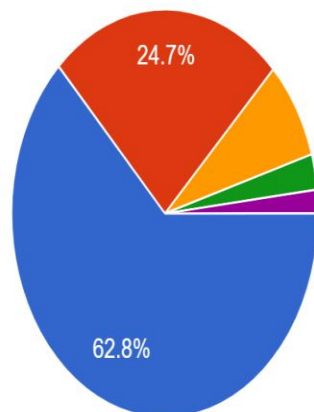

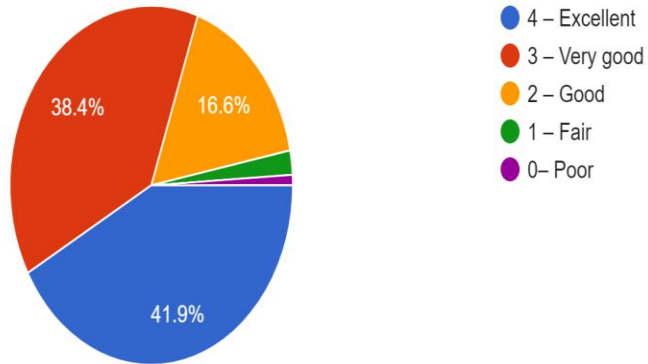

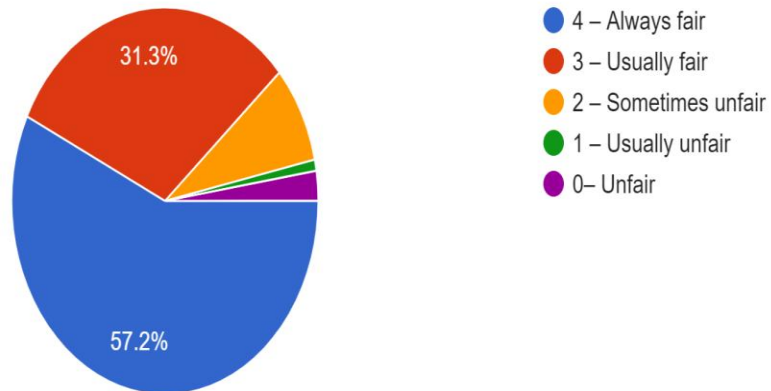

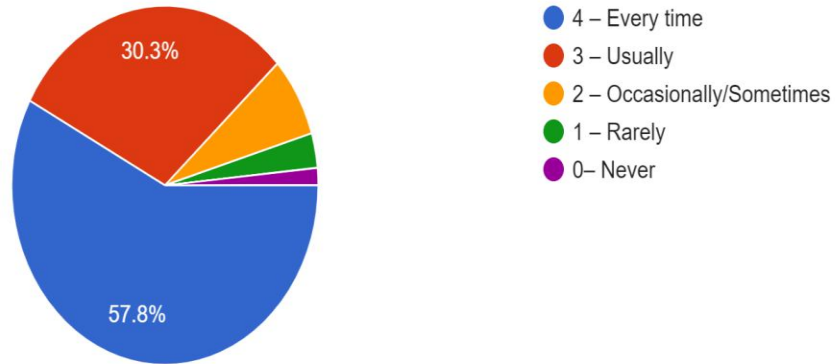
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

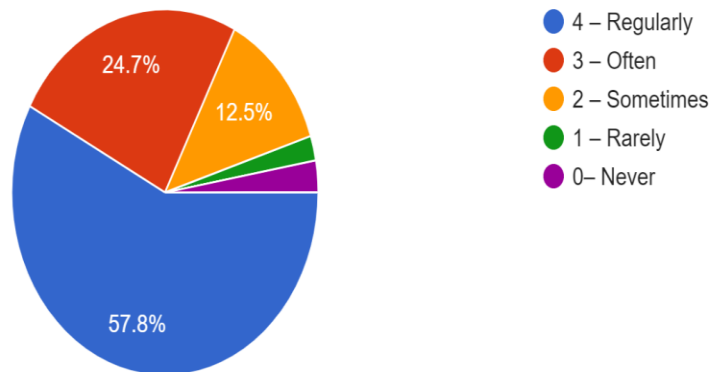
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

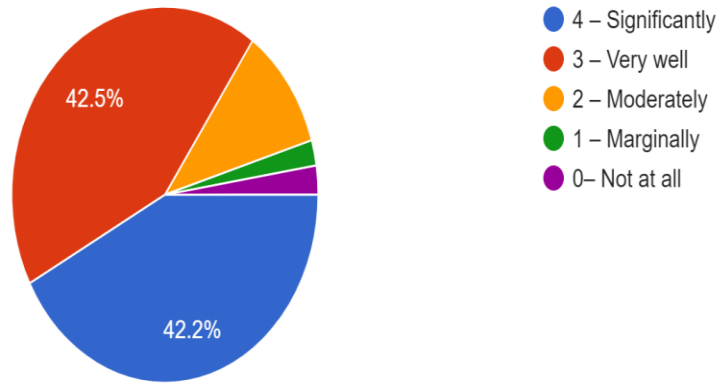

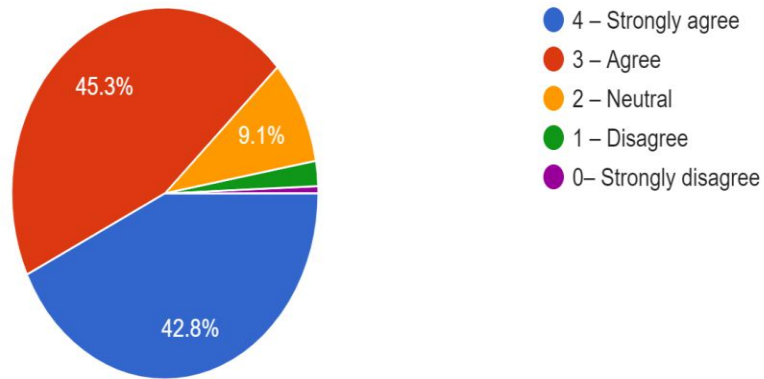

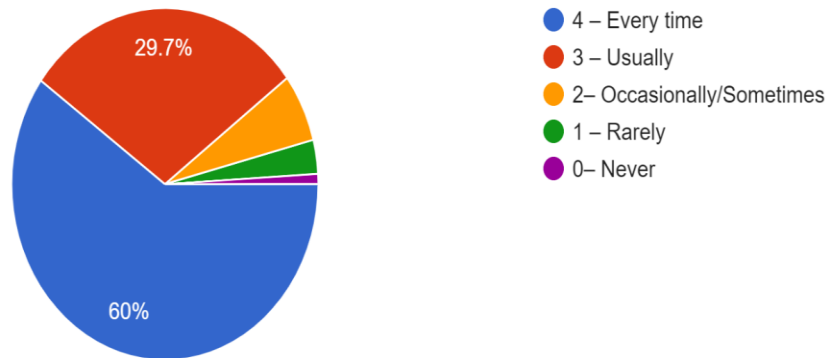

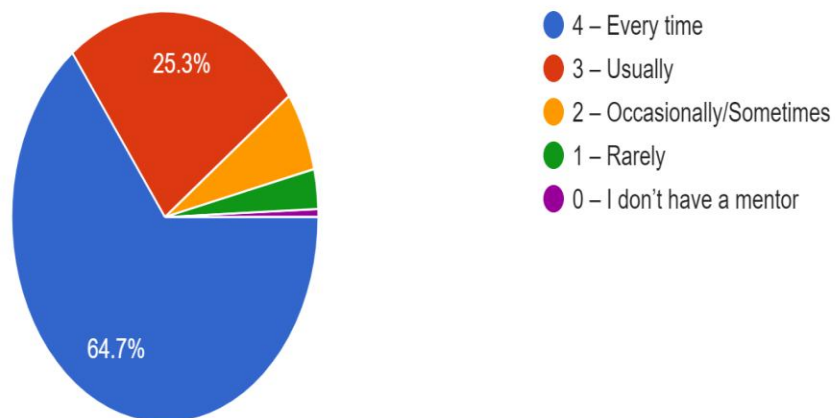

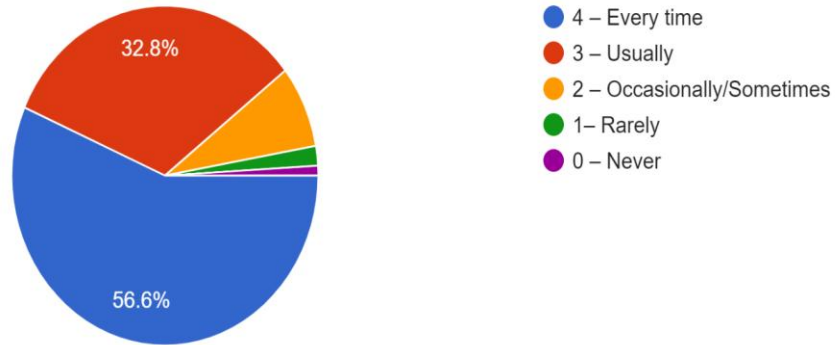

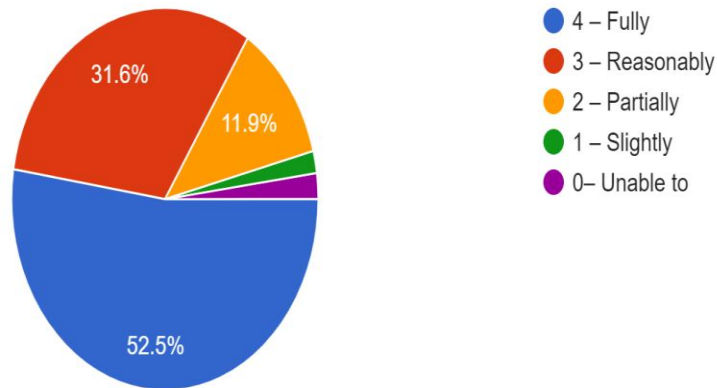

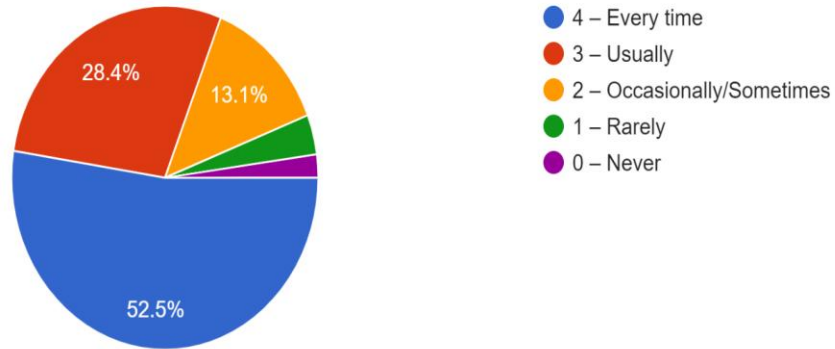

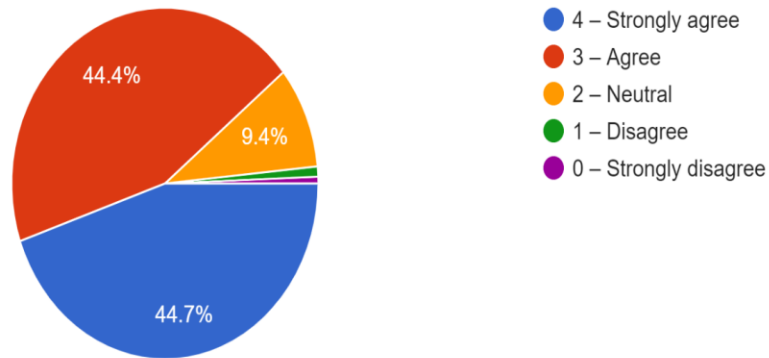

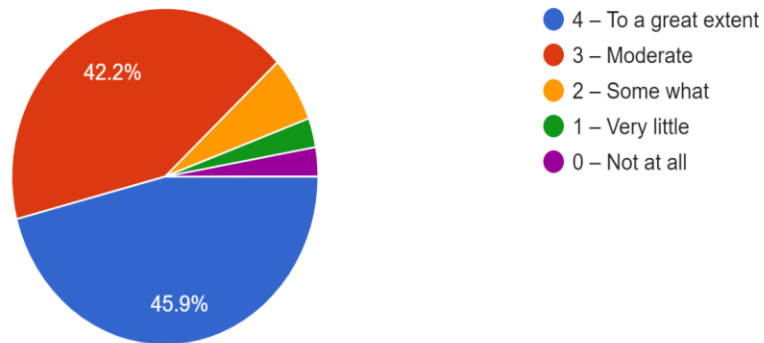

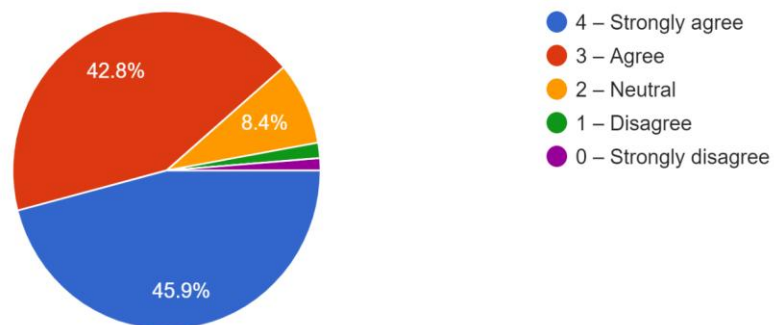

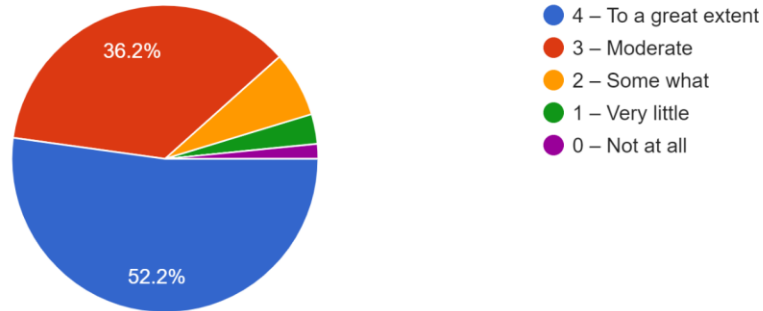

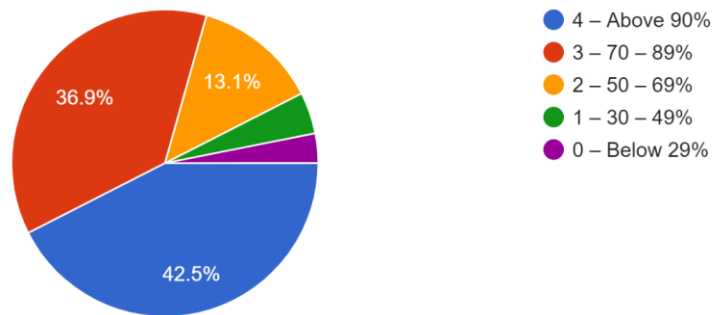
