1. Soft Skill Sessions

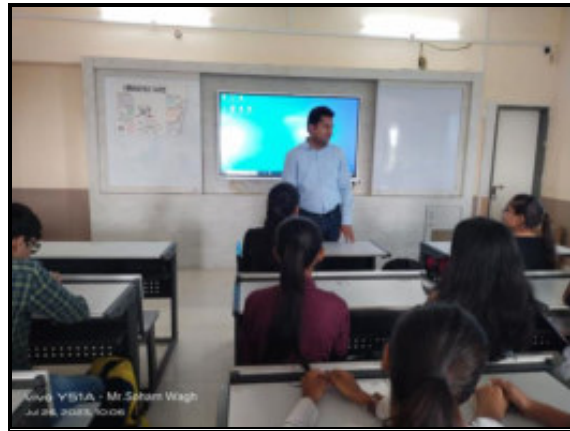

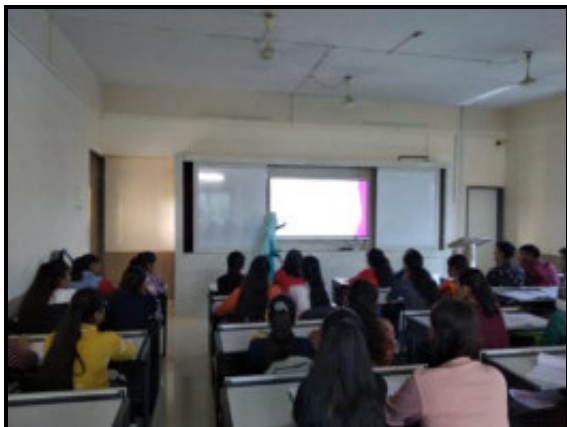
participation. Students gained confidence in presenting themselves during job interviews and learned the art of showcasing their strengths on paper.

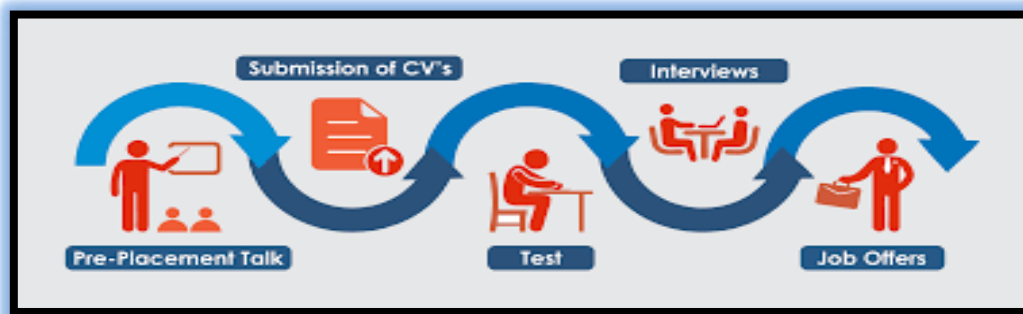

10. 12 Days Infosys Skill Development Training for BCA, BBA and BMS 2023 batch

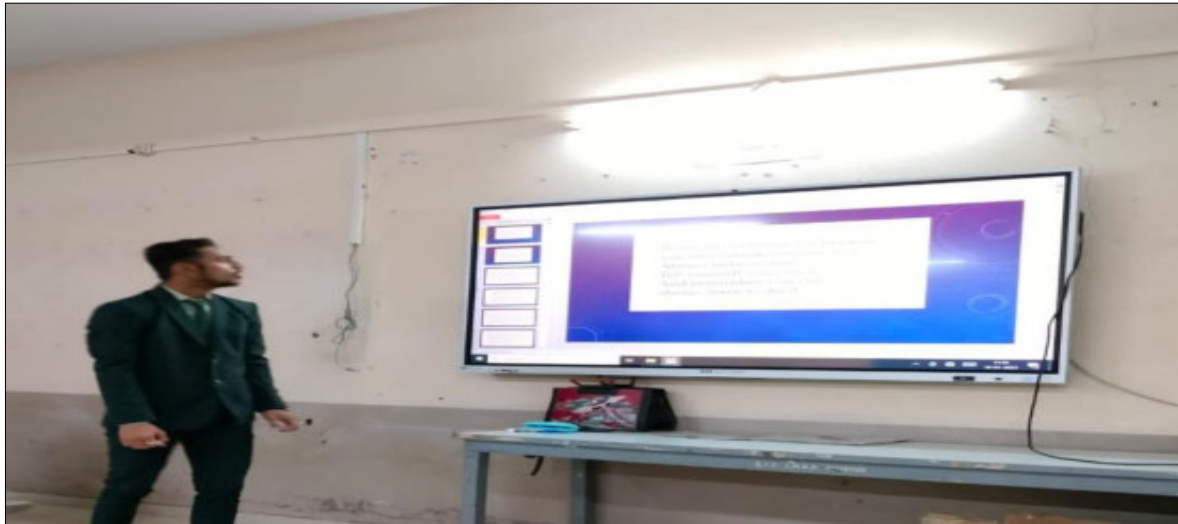

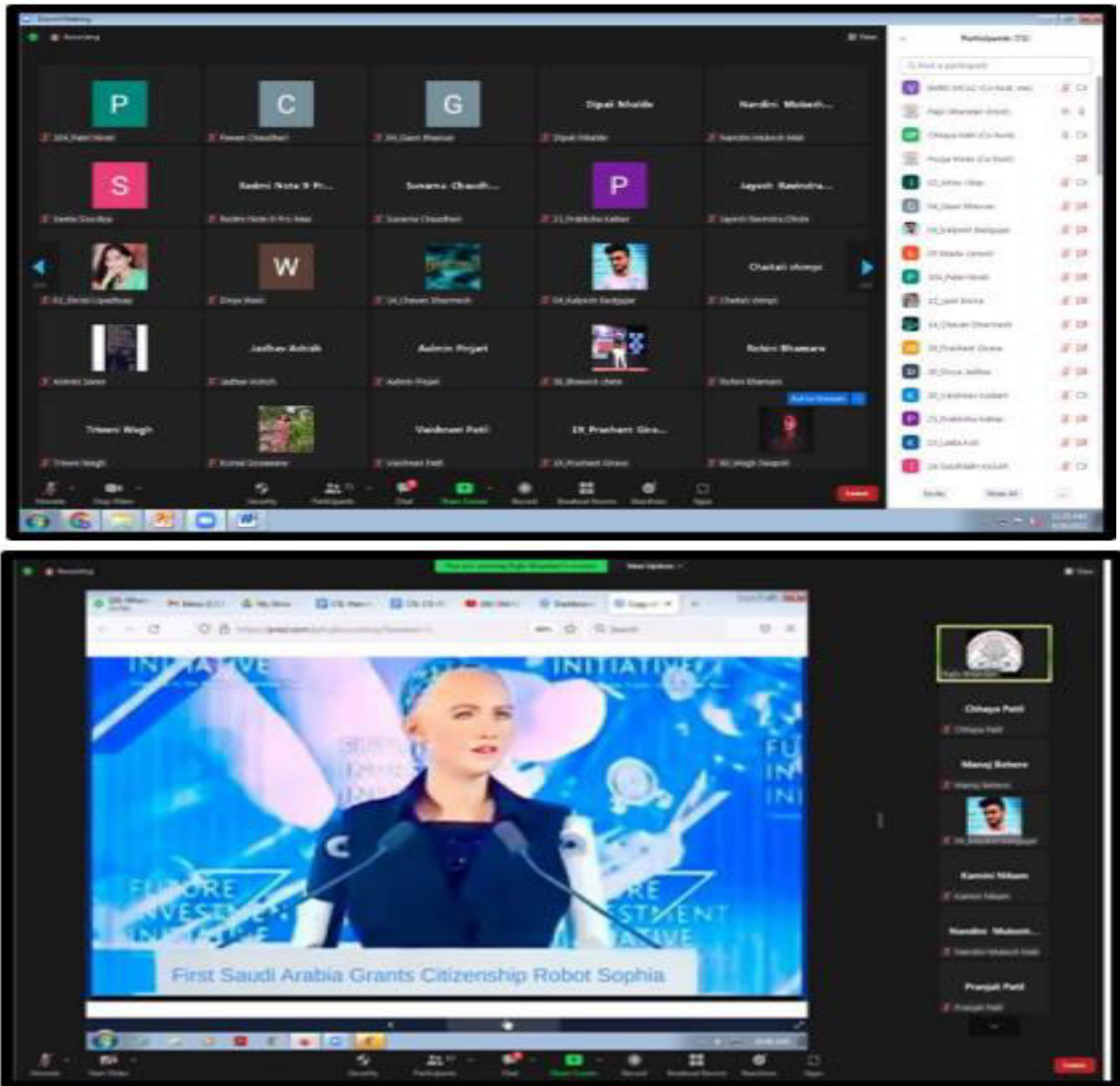

In this Webinar Prof. Sweta Dargad covered following topics:

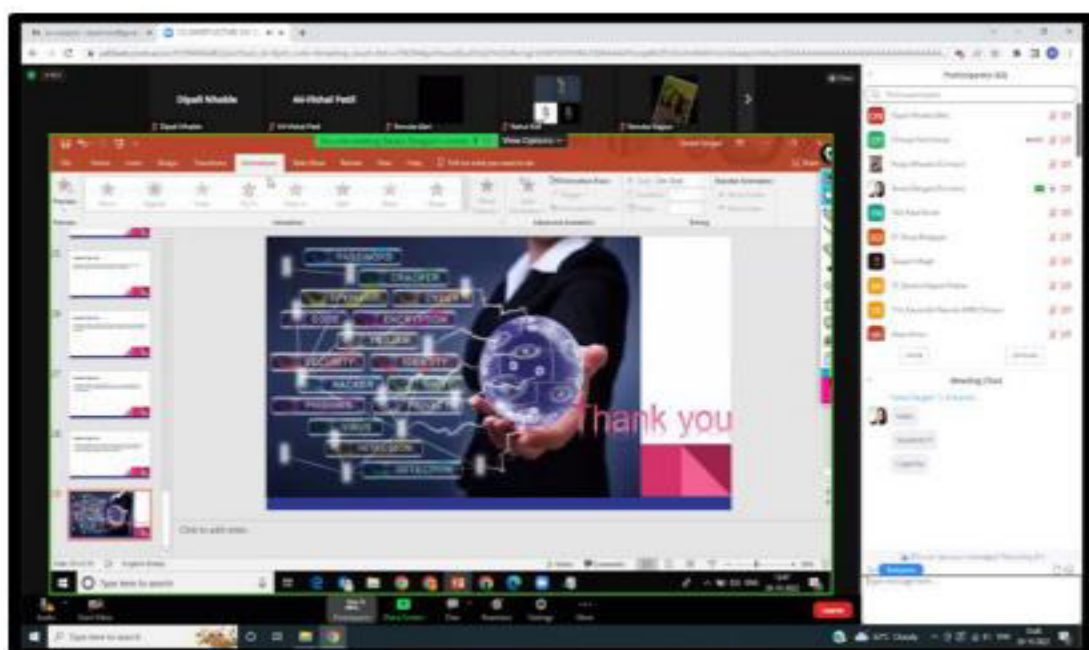
