RCPET's IMRD organized One-Day 2nd National Level Conference on 'Global Business Transformation: Technology, Trends, and Practices' on 5th March 2025.

Prof. Dr. Yamini A. Karmarkar, Director, International Institute of Professional Studies, DAVV, Indore invited as Keynote speaker, Dr. Salil Sabnis, Head- Dept. of Business Administration, R. C. Patel Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Shirpur was invited as the Session Chair and Dr. Vaishali B. Patil, Director, RCPET's IMRD was the Conference Chair for this conference.

In the immense presence of Asst. Director and HOD of MCA & I-MCA Dept. Mr. Manoj Behere, IQAC Co-ordinator Dr. Manoj Patel and HOD of UG Dept. 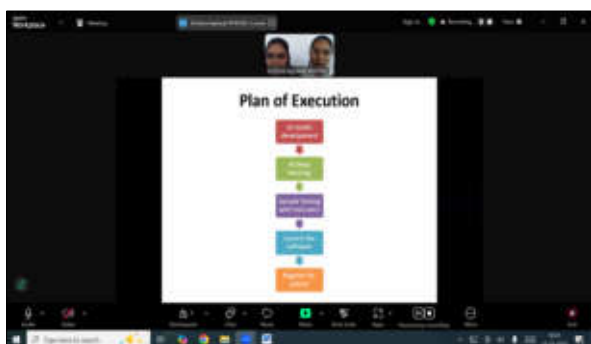

Phase I: Registration and Business Idea Abstract Submission

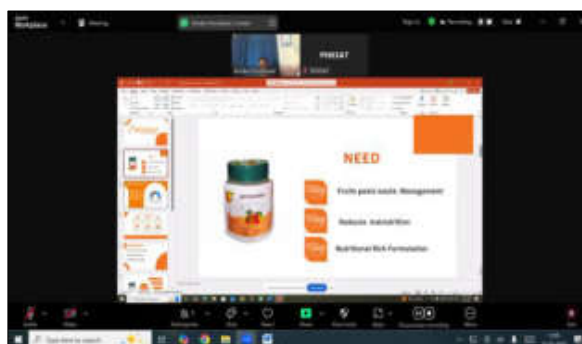

Total 32 teams registered for this phase.

Phase II: Online Presentation

Eligible teams presented online PowerPoint presentations; each team was given eight minutes for presentation followed by a two-minute Q&A session. 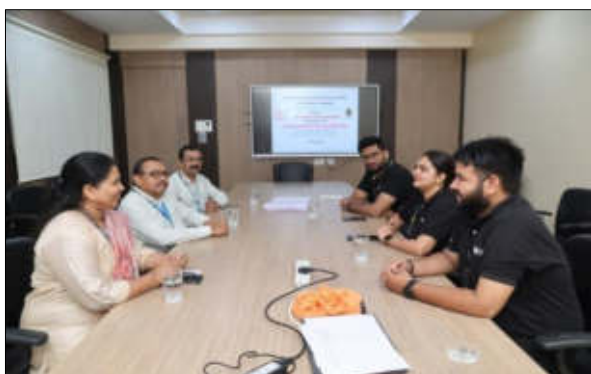

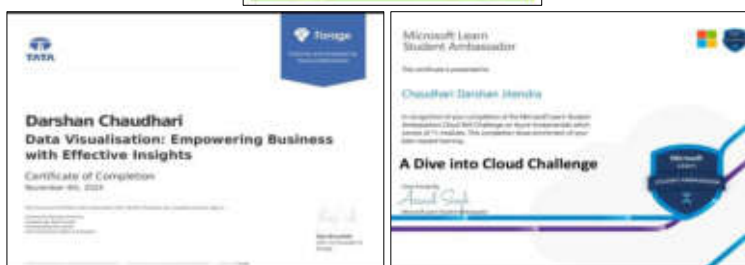
