

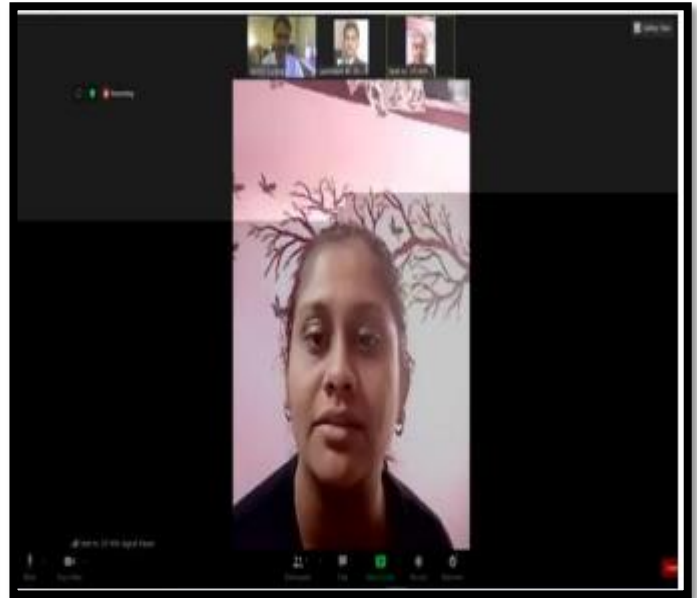

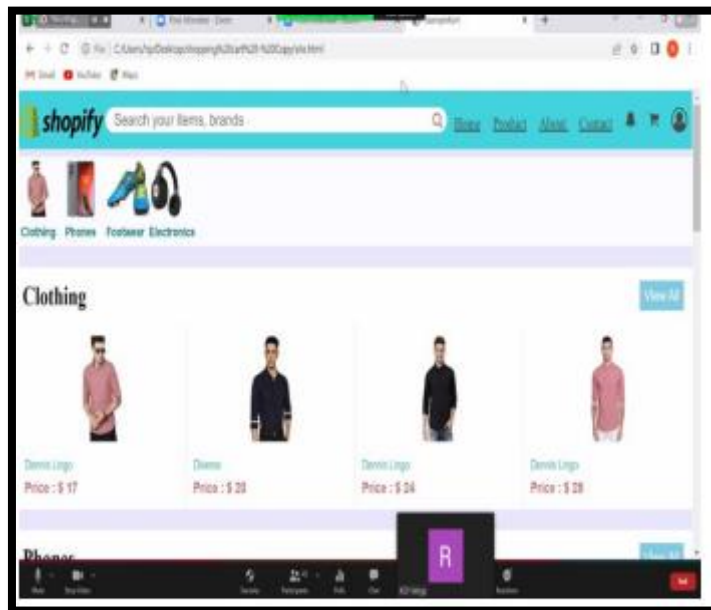
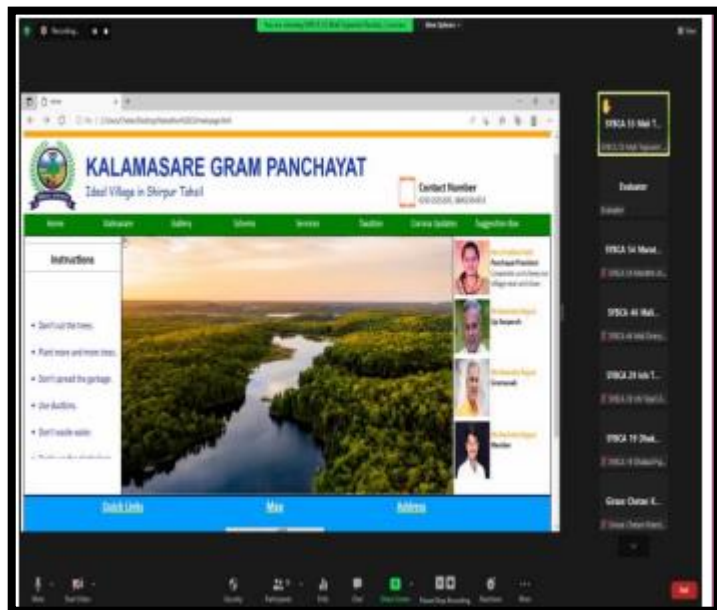
Software Exhibition:

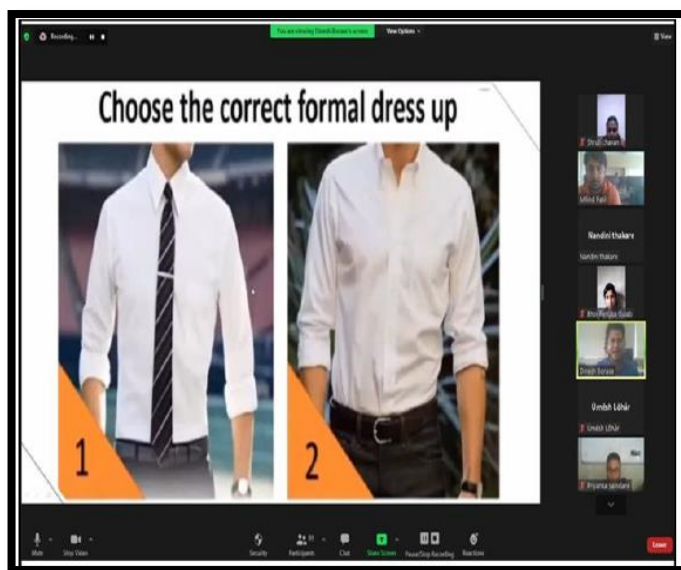
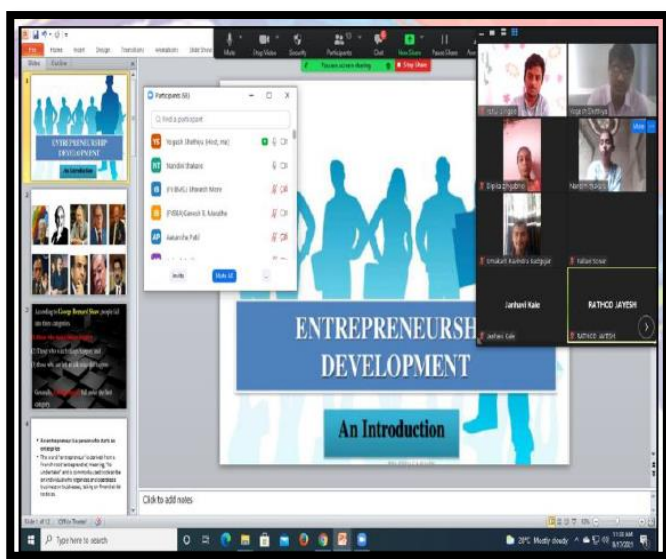
Hackathon 1.0 & 2.0 Competition on Website Design & Exhibition:

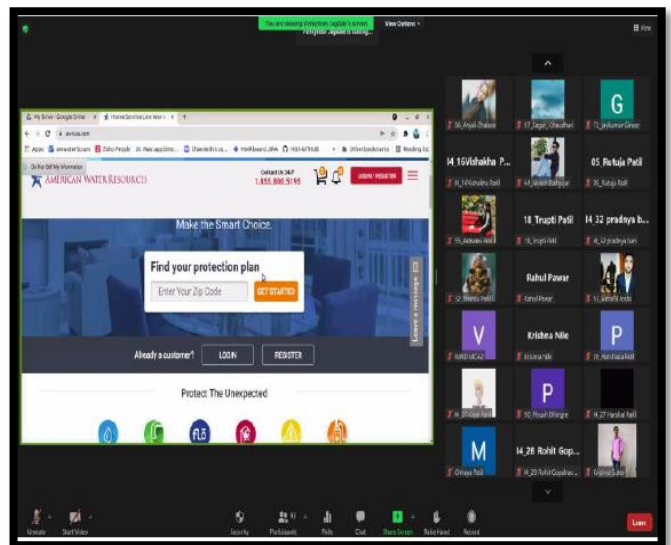
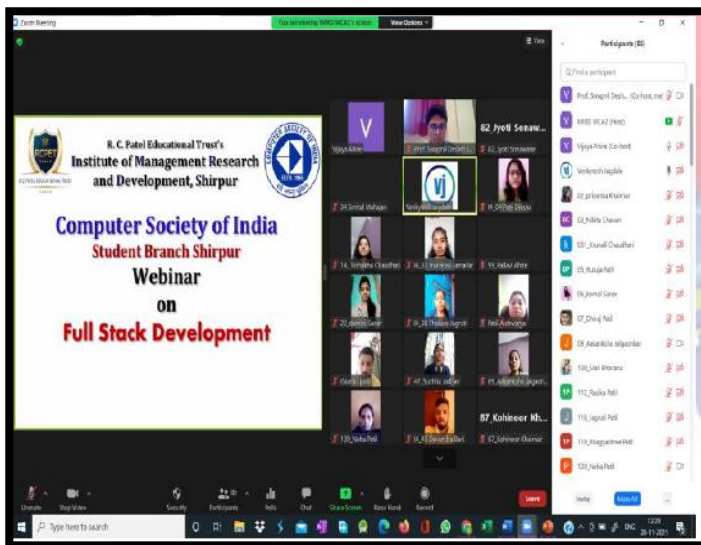
Career Guidance Session for MCA/IMCA Final Year Students:

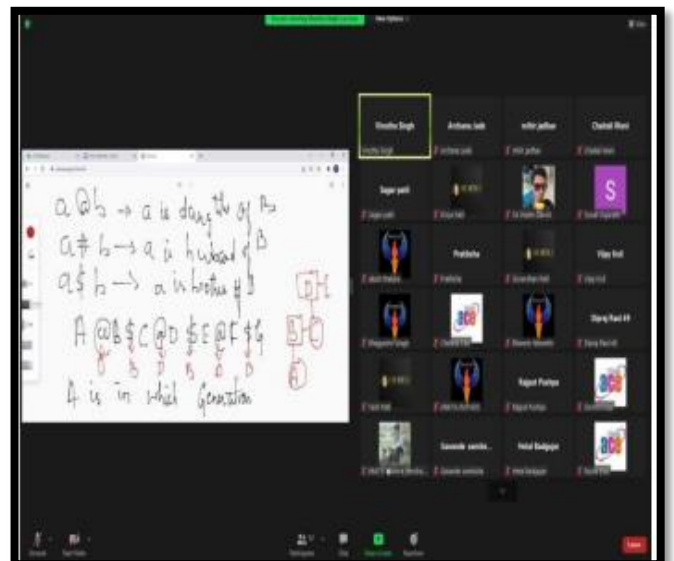
12 Days Skill Development Program:

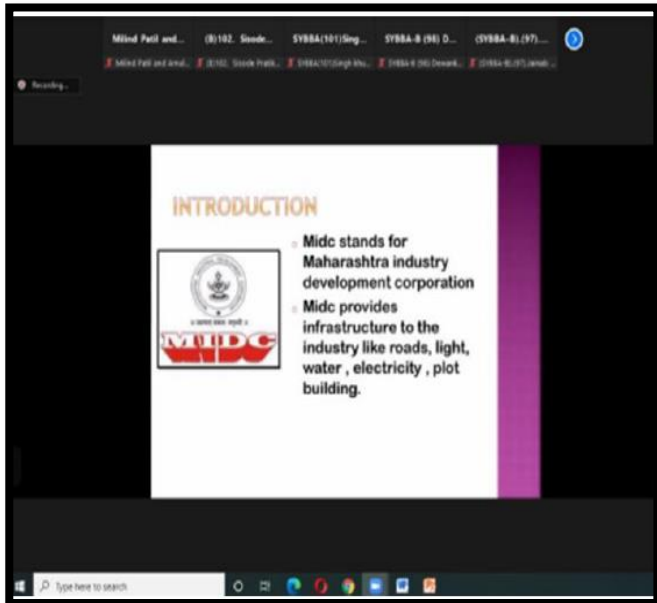
Workshop on Gender Sensitization:

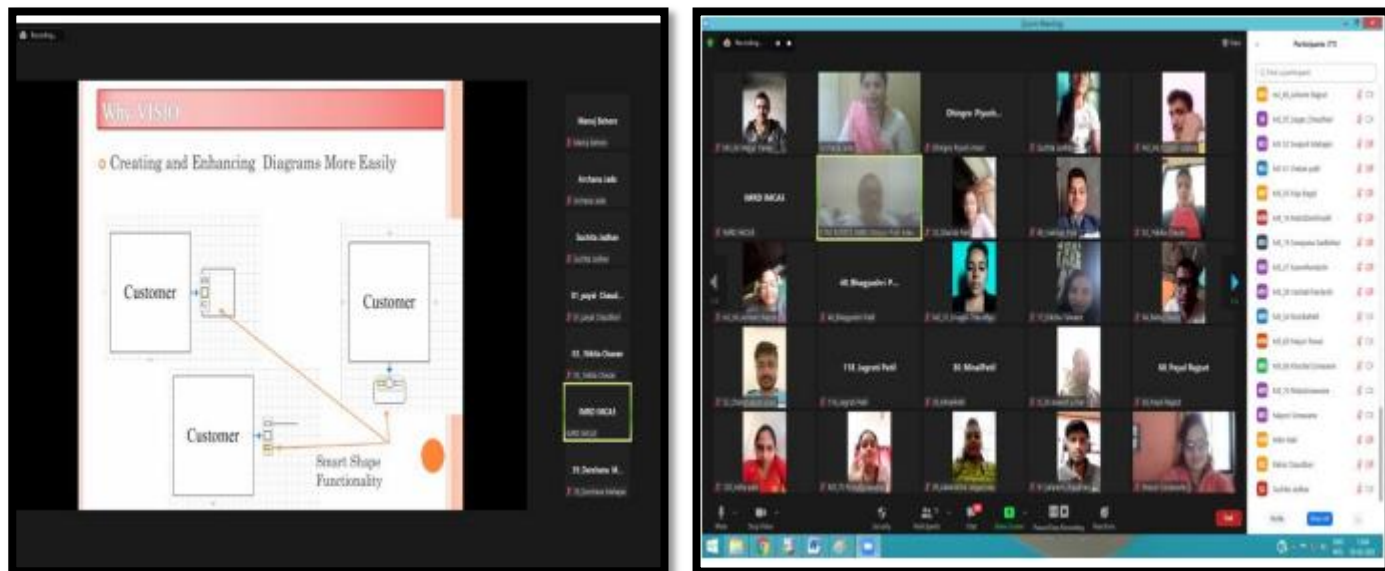
Virtual Power Point Presentation Competition:
