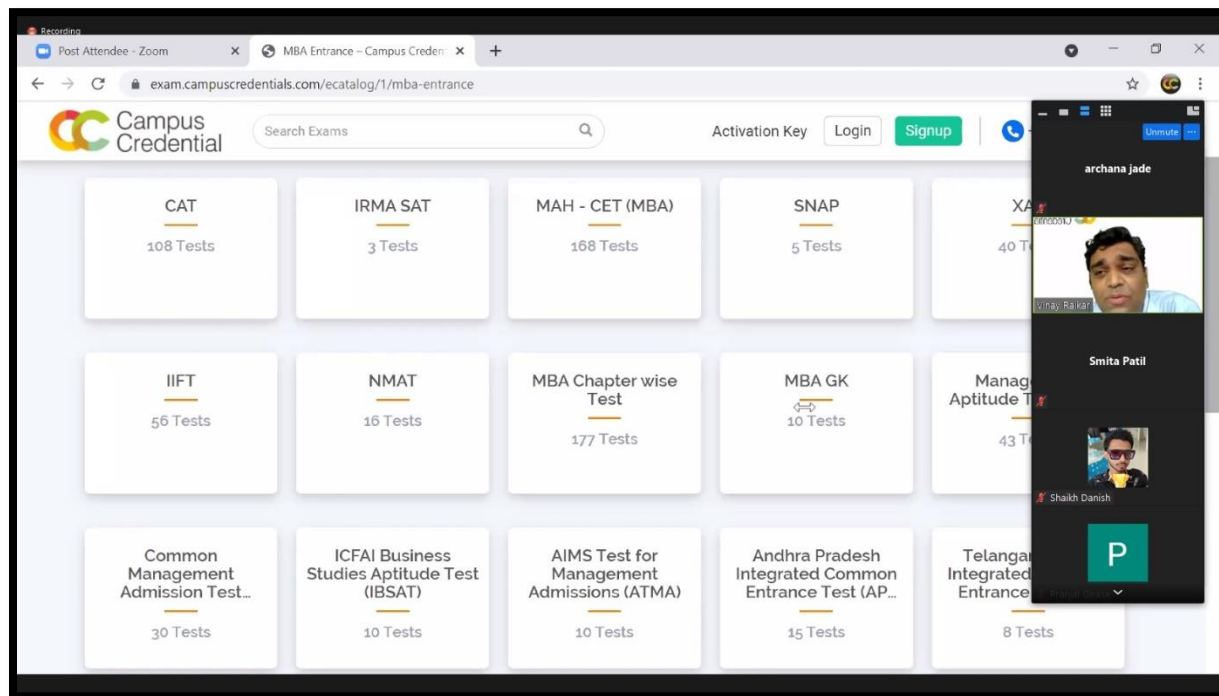

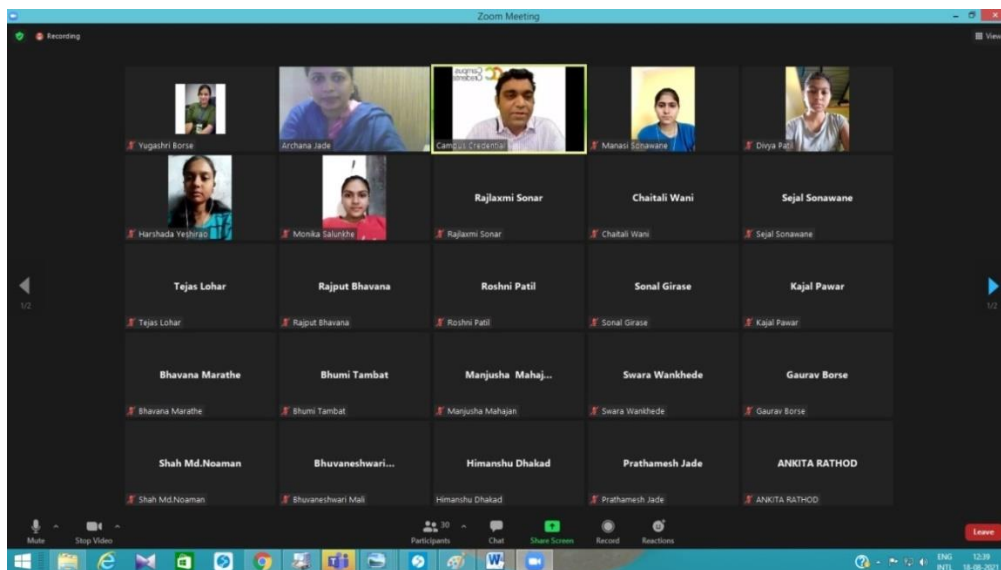

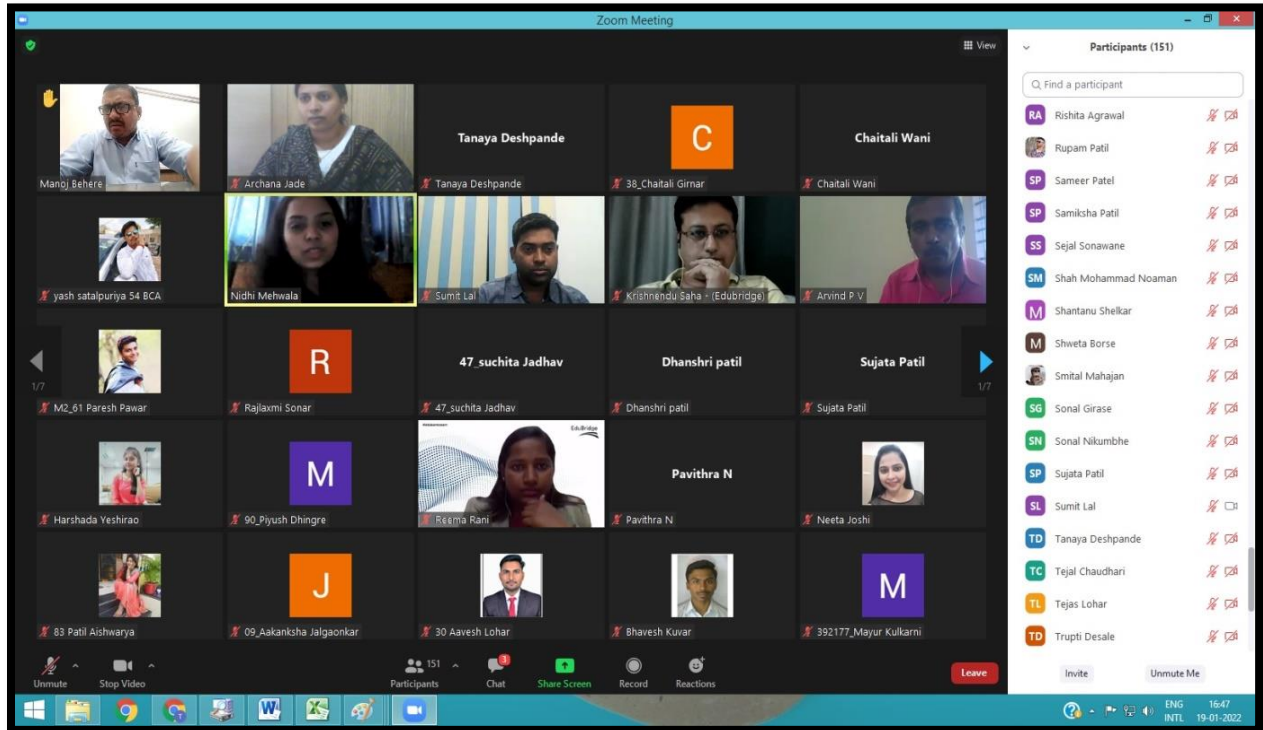



1.7 Campus Credential Training for BCA 72 hours online

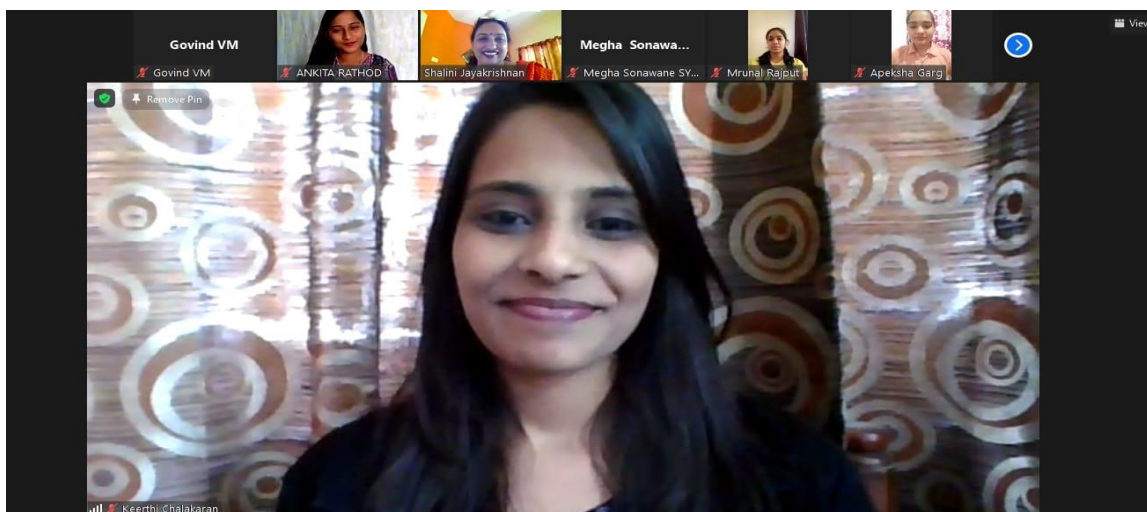

Softskill and technical sessions was also conducted by the team of Campus credential through which they have shared important tips for campus placement to students.

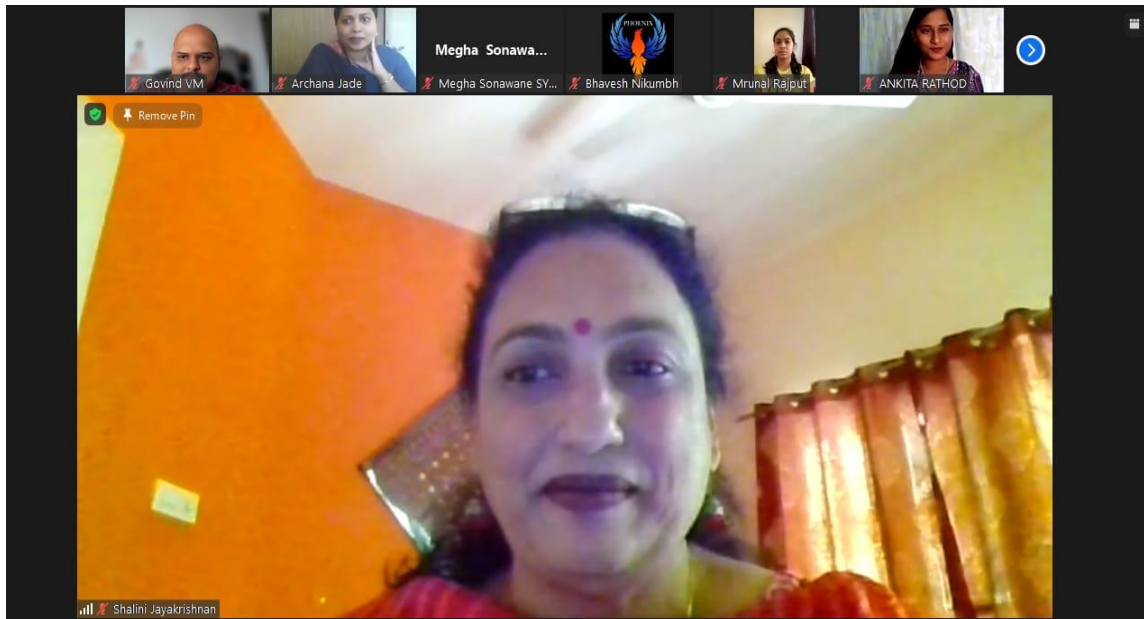
1.8 12 Day's Skill Development Training by Infosys , Bangalore

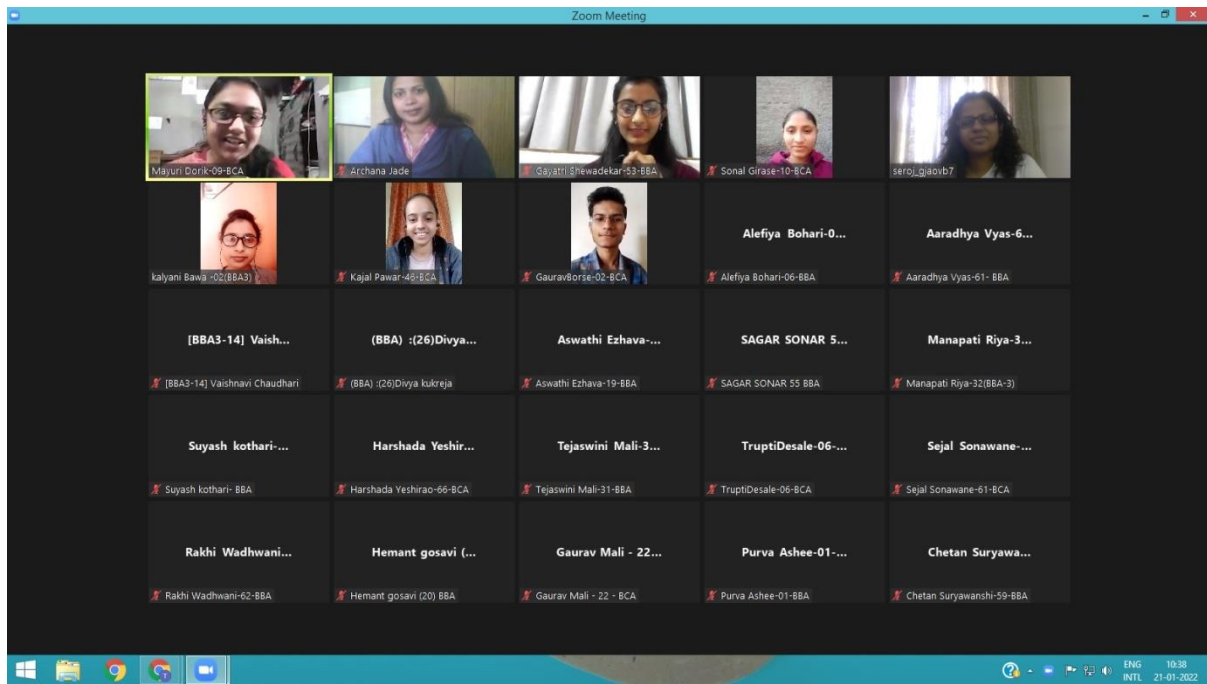

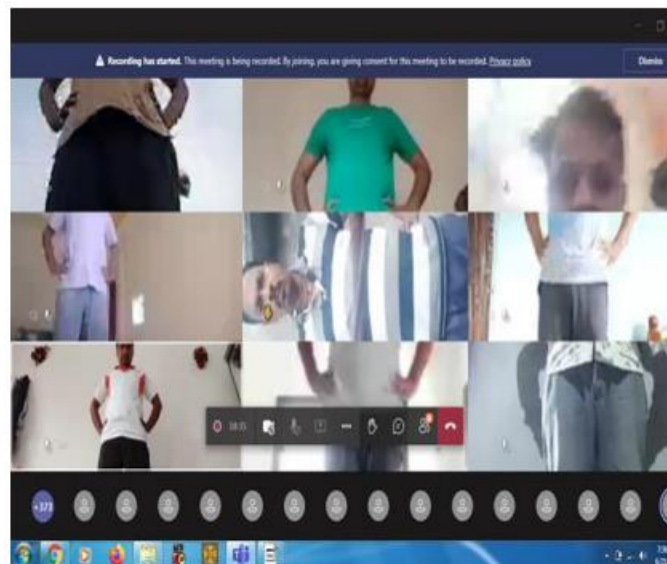
3. Life skills

4.2 Webinar on Robotic Process Automation

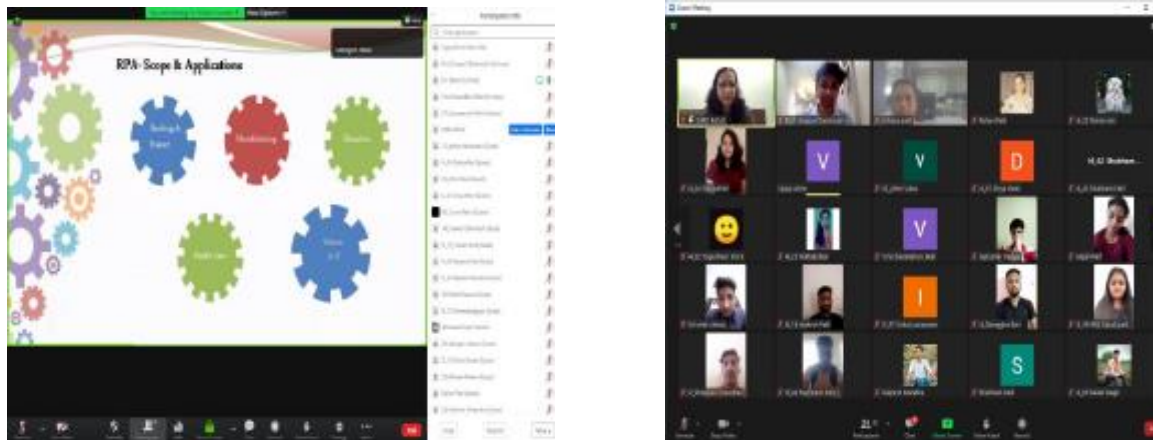

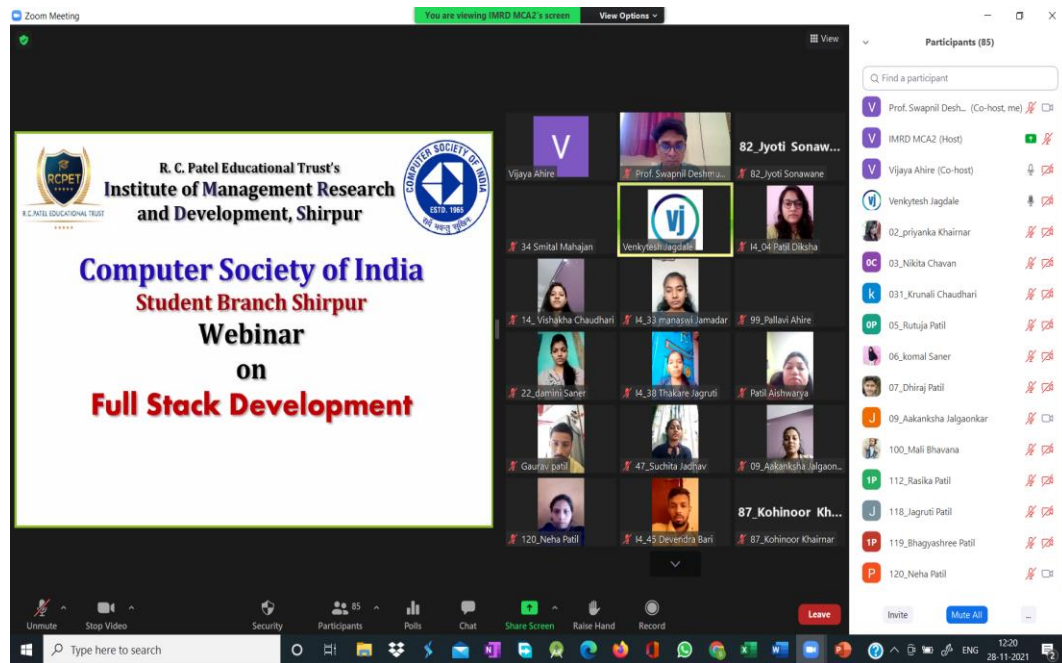
4.3 Webinar on Full Stack Development

live website was also demonstrated which was based on E-commerce. In this demonstration, resource persons explained admin modules, user modules etc.

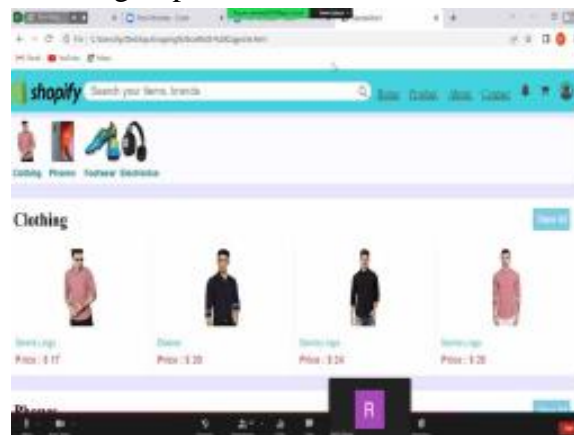
This workshop was the best platform for students to understand the project development process, different modules, functionalities, reports and information structure.
